## PREVENTING AUTO BURGLARIES

Auto burglaries are preventable. There are a few things you must do to prevent from becoming a victim of this type of crime.

Upon reviewing the following listed steps for prevention, it is up to you to continually practice them.

FOLLOW THIS ACRONYM:

### “CLEAR IT”

- C** - Close all windows.
- L** - Lock all doors.
- E** - Eliminate all belongings from plain view.
- A** - Always take vehicle keys.
- R** - Remove garage door opener.
  
- I** - Inform everyone that an anti-theft device is in use.
- T** - Take the time to check all above listed steps prior to leaving your vehicle.

## WHY AUTO BURGLARIES ARE OCCURRING

Auto burglaries have been on the rise, nationwide. This is due to the widespread introduction of new age electronic devices, such as GPS navigational systems, iPod's, MP3's, radar detectors and satellite radio units.

In a large number of recorded incidents, vehicles have been left unlocked.
